You will ski through fields, along the Lillooet River, through forests. <u>Start/Finish is the same location.</u> There will be a sweep of the course at the end of the race.

4/ TRAVEL TO THE START OF THE RACE:

From Downtown Pemberton (Scotia Bank/Pemberton Valley Supermarket)
